

Transport & Logistics Manager

Transport Management:

- Prepare delivery manifests and delivery notes and ensure the acquisition and collation of proof of delivery for all orders

- Identify appropriate software and systems to improve efficiency and effectiveness of transport planning and conformance
- Collect and use data to support business decisions
- Assess the current transport fleet and make recommendations to management on the viable options for continued sustainable operation

Goods Inwards:

- Liaise with the purchasing & supply chain team to understand and plan supplier deliveries.
- Ensure the safe delivery of supplied goods
- Ensure deliveries are complete and in line with the criteria defined by the engineering and supply chain teams
- Ensure all delivered goods are clearly identified and stored in line with operational requirements











Yard Management:

- Manage the yard to ensure the easy identification of finished goods and work in progress
- Define and ensure the adherence to safety rules on the yard leading by example at all times
- Ensure regular regimes to eliminate obsolete and slow-moving goods to allow effective utilisation of space at all times
- Lead transport specific audits
